The first thing you see in a street rod is the paint job. The Adjustable Flexibility Sander (AFS) was invented to create a flawless finish without spending countless hours sanding. Originally created for the automotive industry, carpenters and hobbyists have found these sanders to be a useful tool as well. Not only are they great for the professional but amateurs have also been doing wonders with them.

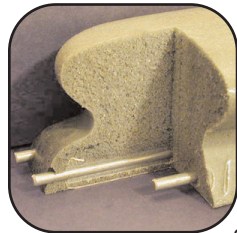


What makes the AFS sanders unique?

By adding or removing flexural rods of the same or different diameters, the sanders attain various levels of flexibility. With no rods inserted, the sander is extremely flexible. As the number of rods inserted increases, so does the stiffness of the sander. You can go from sanding the curved fender of a '40 Chevy to the hood of a '65 Lincoln in a matter of seconds, and still have the optimal contact area from your sander. The flexibility of the sanders helps pick out lows that your hand or naked eye usually miss.

Made in the USA

AFS sanders are made in the USA from high-quality materials. The base plates are made from 1/4 hardened T302 stainless steel on the 9", 15", 21" and 21"-SF, and .050 aluminum on the 36". The flexural rod chases within the sanders are made from polyethylene. The handle is made from the finest polyether foam available and comes from a mold, not from a cheap extrusion process.



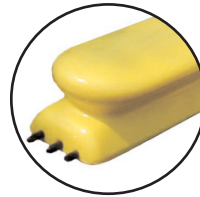
These sanders are constructed so that all metal is protected from digging into the sanding surface.

The base plate is bent up 90° and back in 90° on the ends so the flexural rods don't tear through the foam and scratch your project.

What Type of Sandpaper Does it Use?

Use adhesive backed sandpaper, or a type of spray adhesive to apply the sandpaper. Why don't they have clips on them? Clips don't keep the sandpaper attached to the bottom of the sander as well. Spray adhesive won't allow the paper to be drawn into the lows while you're sanding.

Standard AFS Sanders are available in four sizes: 9, 15, 21, & 36-inch. The Standard sanders have a durable foam rubber handle and come with 2 sets of rods (except the 9") and a set of vinyl end caps.



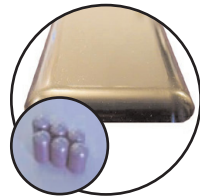
The 6" sanders are non-adjustable, hand-held sanders. They come in 4 different levels of hardness, which are comparable to the following: gum eraser, pencil eraser, radiator hose, and extension cord plug.



Special Edition sanders are available for all sanders in any color combination you can imagine. Choose your favorite sports team colors or try a groovy tie dye combination.



The Super Flex was built for people that work on seriously curved panels and want the best. This sander takes flexibility and durability to the limits. Ideal for Model A's, T's, and many cars from the 30's.



Accessories such as a 1/2" rubber sole and end caps are available. The rubber sole applies to bottom of base plate for sanding concave surfaces. Vinyl end caps protect your project from scratches.
